Staging Requirements—(TBD) for Theater, Arts Centers, Private/Corporate dates:

- Stage Width = 24 feet wide
- Upstage to downstage = 20 feet
- If up-stage/down-stage space is tight, implementing additional 4' X 8' platform thrust (down-stage center into audience may be needed -**TBD**
- Stage should have a black skirting around perimeter.
- Pipe and drape full curtain hung as back-drop and the full width of the stage
- Video Screen or I-Mag may also be used-TBD-not necessary

Stage Layout

- Drums—upstage & center (drum riser is preferred)
